FIRE SAFETY

Thankfully relatively few people have been involved in a fire, therefore the majority have little knowledge of the actions required to prevent or even survive a fire. Unfortunately for some, their first introduction to fire is often their last.



Fire Safety in the Home

We will show the main causes of fire in the home and how it burns using conduction, convection, radiation and direct burning and how we can prevent that happening. Part two discusses the need for smoke alarms, explaining the optimum position to fix your alarm and why, how to test your alarms and the frequency of those tests. What to do in the event of a fire, how to escape if unfortunate enough to be involved, and how to exit a building safely using Fire Escape Plans.

After attending Fire Awareness training with 'Manchester Safety Training' you will have knowledge of the reality of fire and how unpredictable it is, how it spreads using Back drafts and Flash-overs and the speed with which the flames and smoke travel, also ensuring you understand the procedures when evacuating a premise involved in fire.

Discuss the laws in place to ensure the perpetrators are discouraged from making the call, for whatever reason.

In the weeks leading up to any Religious Festivals throughout the year where Bonfires / Fireworks are to be used, this hard hitting, thought provoking presentation will highlight the considerations undertaken and dangers associated with building Bonfires.

Utilizing over 30 years experience in the Fire and Rescue Service aided with photographs and video clips, 'Manchester Safety Training' will show the serious, sometimes fatal injuries sustained when using Fireworks, and the heartache and pain on family and friends. The workshop will prove that organized events are far safer than a private party in a garden or on waste land.
